New Security Protocol at Gables One Tower Starting June 1, 2019

What is the new security protocol at GOT?

- Effective June 1, 2019:
 - All exterior entrances to GOT will require Cane Card access 24/7, with the exception of the main lobby (entry facing US1), which will remain open Monday-Friday from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.
 - Entrances to the HR and Controller office suites off the main lobby of GOT will require Cane Card access to enter.
 - In accordance with the University's security protocol, anyone working at and/or visiting GOT should have their Cane Card visible at all times.

Why are the changes being made at GOT?

• To provide a safer and more secure work environment for our University of Miami staff and patrons at GOT and prevent unauthorized access into the building.

I lost or need to renew my card.

• Please visit Parking and Transportation at the McKnight building before June 1 to receive a replacement Cane Card at no cost to you.

I am a Medical campus employee working at GOT and need an update to my card?

 Please visit Parking and Transportation (P&T) at the McKnight building before June. The P&T team will record your name and work with Campus Safety at the Medical campus to receive a replacement Cane Card at no cost to you.

I need to change the type of access I have on my card.

 Please work with your supervisor to submit an access request online at <u>miami.edu/SRO</u> specifying in detail the type of request and your C#.

Will the all the suites in GOT also be restricted?

• Only entrances to the HR and Controller office suites off the main lobby of GOT will require Cane Card access to enter.
