- Fulltime faculty members who are in their early career or new to HIV and Mental Health Research
- Post-doctoral fellows

- Letter of Intent (LOI) (required for post-doctoral fellows) due June 4, 2023, 5 PM EST
- Speed Review (optional) due June 28, 2023, 5 PM EST, and
- a Full Application due August 30, 2023, at 5 PM EST
